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WHAT IS RESPONSIBLE INVESTMENT (RI)?

Responsible investment involves considering environmental, social and governance (ESG) issues when making investment decisions.

Active ownership or stewardship influences companies or asset management in managing the volatility and risks in investments. It complements traditional financial analysis and portfolio construction techniques.



Responsible investors can have different objectives:



Financial Returns-Focused

Some focus exclusively on financial returns, considering the impact of Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) issues on financial outcomes.



Sustainable Impact-Focused

Others aim to generate economic returns while achieving positive outcomes for people and the planet, avoiding negative impacts.

WHAT ARE UN-SUPPORTED PRINCIPLES FOR RESPONSIBLE INVESTMENT?

The PRI is a global organisation that encourages and supports the investment industry in investing responsibly. It is also the world's leading proponent of responsible investment.

Upon becoming a signatory, individuals or entities commit to following the six Principles for Responsible Investment.



WHAT ARE THE SIX PRINCIPLES FOR RESPONSIBLE INVESTMENT?

The six Principles for Responsible Investment are **a voluntary set of investment principles that offer a menu of possible actions for incorporating environmental, social and governance (ESG) issues into investment practice.** The Principles were developed by investors, under the leadership of the United Nations (UN). They have attracted a global signatory base representing a majority of the world's professionally managed investments.

We will incorporate ESG issues into investment analysis and decision-making processes.



We will be active owners and incorporate ESG issues into our ownership policies and practices.



We will seek appropriate disclosure on ESG issues by the entities in which we invest.



We will each report on our activities and progress towards implementing the Principles.

We will promote acceptance and implementation of the Principles within the investment industry.

We will work together to enhance our effectiveness in implementing the Principles.
